


# Applying for NAHU Awards





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## Max Points Tips

- You get Bonus Points just for the quality of your submission. Maximize yours by following the format of the Award.
- You get big points when your leaders attend certain events and sessions. Know the who, what, where and when and be sure they do as well.
- You miss out on points for a budget and financials if they're not noted as approved, don't forget that step.
- Chapters with an Annual Summary Report pick up 50 sweet points toward Landmark / Pacesetter Award!
- Chapters that conduct a Member Needs Survey get more than just great insights – that's right, more points!
- Does your chapter support the NAHU Education Foundation? Yep, you get points for that too!

# More Ways to Score Big

- Document those Membership Campaigns and Contests.
- Present NAHU's turnkey training for extra points.
- Promote LPRT and Triple Crown 3x per year.
- Submit letters to the editor and op-eds.
- Celebrate your rockstars with a with a publicized awards & recognition program.

It's also a team sport – the Awards Chair is just the coach, the entire board must participate for success.



Highlighting key info in a dense document works wonders, and one comprehensive attachment beats several separate bits.



It's OK to use the same documentation for multiple sections, but do us all a favor and attach it everywhere it's being used.

**Board Meeting Minutes** 



Flyers, Registration Forms, Announcements with the date, location, who's hosting/sponsoring, and the agenda



Signed contracts with date and location of event



Confirmation emails, letters, press materials.



# Easy Ways to Mess Up

- Missing, incomplete or non-qualifying documentation
- Board chairs not reported to NAHU
- Claiming points for another chapter's achievements
- Expired insurance policy documents
- Not utilizing the current Awards Guidebook
